



WHO WE SERVE

In 2013, Triad Health Project served 2,496 people through a combination of direct client services to people living with HIV/AIDS, HIV and other STI testing, and HIV prevention and education programs. The following statistics provide a demographic profile of our clients.

DIRECT CLIENT SERVICES: Served - 522 clients

GENDER: Male - 62% Female - 37% Transgender - 1%

RACE AND ETHNICITY: Caucasian - 14% African American - 80% Hispanic - 2% Other - 4%

AGE: 0-24 - 5% 25-49 - 51% 50+ - 44%

MODE OF TRANSMISSION: Heterosexual contact - 50%
 Heterosexual contact & IV drug use - 3% IV drug use - 7%

MSM - 27% MSM & heterosexual contact - 1%

MSM & IV drug use - 3% Other or Unknown- 8% Perinatal - 1%

• 83% of THP clients were living at or below the Federal Poverty Level

• 96% of THP clients reported a history of some complicating factor, such as homelessness, substance abuse, or mental illness

TESTING: Tested 961 people

NUMBER OF FULL SCREENS (Testing for HIV, syphilis, gonorrhea, and Chlamydia): 705 people

GENDER: Male - 46% Female - 53% Transgender - 1%

RACE AND ETHNICITY: Caucasian - 33%

African American - 53% Hispanic - 13%

Other or unreported - 1%

AGE: 24 or younger - 53% 25-49 - 40% 50+ - 7%

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING: Approximately 1,500 people
