



### WHO WE SERVE

In 2013-2014, Triad Health Project served 2,423 people through a combination of direct client services to people living with HIV/AIDS, HIV and other STI testing, and HIV prevention and education programs. The following statistics provide a demographic profile of our clients.

**DIRECT CLIENT SERVICES:** Served – 530 clients

**GENDER:** Male – 62% Female – 37% Transgender – 1%

**RACE AND ETHNICITY:** Caucasian – 14% African American – 76% Hispanic – 3% Other – 7%

**AGE:** 0-24 – 5% 25-49 – 49% 50+ – 46%

**MODE OF TRANSMISSION:** Heterosexual contact - 49%  
Heterosexual contact & IV drug use - 2% IV drug use - 6%  
MSM - 29% MSM & heterosexual contact - 1%

MSM & IV drug use - 3% Other or Unknown – 9% Perinatal - 1%

• 85% of THP clients were living at or below the Federal Poverty Level

• 93% of THP clients reported a history of some complicating factor, such as homelessness, substance abuse, or mental illness

**TESTING:** Tested 827 people

**NUMBER OF FULL SCREENS** (Testing for HIV, syphilis, gonorrhea, and Chlamydia): 669 people

**GENDER:** Male – 49% Female – 51% Transgender – 1%

**RACE AND ETHNICITY:** Caucasian – 28%

African American – 57% Hispanic – 13%

Other or unreported – 2%

**AGE:** 24 or younger – 54% 25-49 – 40% 50+ – 6%

**EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING:** Approximately 1,056 people

**FREE CONDOMS DISTRIBUTED:** 17,850 condoms
